











The MS latch lock is an access interlock which is suitable for use on hinged and sliding doors. The interlock is made of copper brushed aluminium, making it ideal for use in harsh or corrosive environments and heavy use.

Typical industries using the MS latch lock are cement & aggregates, mining, iron & steel, metallurgy, rail and power generation.

The MS latch lock is modular.

#### **USAGE**

The MS Access Interlock can be used to allow safe access to potential hazardous and dangerous areas.

The MS Access Interlock can be used with one key on part body access doors where the use of personal safety keys is not essential or with 2 keys (consignment key) on full body access doors where the use of personal safety keys is essential (to prevent accidental lock in).



The MS Access Interlock is not designed for the security of building access.

#### **INSTALLATION**



A safety lock must be fitted with suitable fasteners.

Important:

To prevent unauthorized removal, the lock must be mounted using rivets or M5 stainless steel safety fixing screws (washers, nuts and screws).

The installation must be carried out by a competent and qualified person who has read and understood these instructions.

In case of vibrations, contact STI.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

Periodic visual checks should be carried out to check for deformation or corrosion/erosion/acid aggregating by the site manager/safety officer. Clearing the marking/closing of the lock attachment.

Do not lubricate lock barrel with oil or grease, use Powder Graphite if necessary.

#### **APPLICATION**


A typical application of the MS Access Interlock with trapped key in machine guarding with full body access.

The MS latch lock can be used as part of a safety system, which ensures a machine is shut down, before access to the hazardous area is allowed.

The system is composed of a RTK\*E key switch for the electrical supply, to isolate the electrical supply to the machine. This key is taken to the MS Access Interlock and inserted into the lock.

This allows the release of the personnel safety key and then the latch can be release. The personnel key is then taken into the area by the operative to safeguard themselves against accidental lock in and prematured start up.


The machine cannot be restarted until the personnel key is returned, the latch is locked replaced and the isolation key is removed and transferred back to the RTK\*E key switch.




DRAWING Dimensions: in mm
